Regulation on the arrangement of "My School is 20" video clip competition dedicated to the 20th anniversary of Miras International School.

- 1. General provisions
- 1.1. School video clip competition called "My School is 20" (hereinafter referred to as Competition) is held as a part of celebration of 20th anniversary of Miras International School in Almaty.
- 1.2. The organizers of the Competition are Miras International School Almaty Administration (hereinafter referred to as School).
- 1.3. Participants of the Competition: school students of Grades 4-12, homeroom leaders, teachers, school staff, graduates (different years), and parents.
- 2. Goals and Objectives of the Competition.
- 2.1. The goal of the Competition is to create a video material about school history and traditions (educational, cultural and sports) as well as students, graduates and teachers.
- 2.2. The Objectives of the Competition
- develop good school traditions;
- develop a respectful attitude towards school;
- develop creative potential and leadership qualities in students;
- arouse interest in deep study of ICT.
- 3. Time of the Competition and Participation Application Submission Procedure:
- 3.1. The Competition will take place in several stages:
- from 05.02.2019 to 06.02.2019 posting information about the competition on the school website and Instagram, and sending it through WhatsApp and e-mail.
- from 07.02.2019 to 15.02.2019 accepting video clips for the competition;
- from 18.02.2019 to 20.02.2019 assessing the video clips and summarizing.
- from 21.02.19- demonstrating the video clips on the school official website and through social networks such as Instagram and Facebook.
- 4. Video Clip Requirements
- 4.1. The video clips should be in English, Kazakh and Russian and should not exceed 30 seconds.

- 4.2. The topic of the competition is "My School is 20".
- 4.3 Every video clip must start with a video background symbolizing 20th anniversary of the school.
- 4.4. A participant (students, homeroom leaders, teachers, school staff, graduates and parents) may submit only one video clip.
- 4.5. Inaccurate information or inappropriate language may not be used in the clip.
- 4.6 The clips will only be posted on social media after the competition results have been summed up and School Administration authorized them.
- 4.7. The Competition Organizers reserve the right not to consider a clip in the following cases:
- plagiarism has been detected;
- a clip submitted does not meet one of the requirements stipulated by this Regulation.
- 5. Competition Commission and Assessment Criteria
- 5.1. The Commission consists of School Administration, PTA representatives, and Primary and Secondary School Student Council representatives.
- 5.2. Main Assessment Criteria:
- originality of the idea;
- accuracy of the presented information;
- informational content;
- quality of the performance (video).
- 5.3. The highest grade for each criteria is 5.
- 5.4. The decision of the Competition Commission is not disputed and is not subject to revision
- 6. Summing up and awarding the participants of the Competition.
- 6.1. The winner of the Competition is determined by the amount of grades awarded by the Competition Commission.
- 6.2. The winner and prize-winners are awarded certificates (diplomas) and prizes.
- 6.3. The competition participants will receive certificates of participation.
